Recognized as having the most diverse delivery model of early education in Louisiana, Clover Early Learning Services' broad reach includes:

- Center-based Early Head Start and Head Start
- Home-based *Parents as Educators* program for pregnant mothers and families with children from birth to 3
- Educare New Orleans School at Columbia Parc
- Partnerships with 10 independent child care sites in Orleans and Jefferson Parishes

Services include but not limited to:

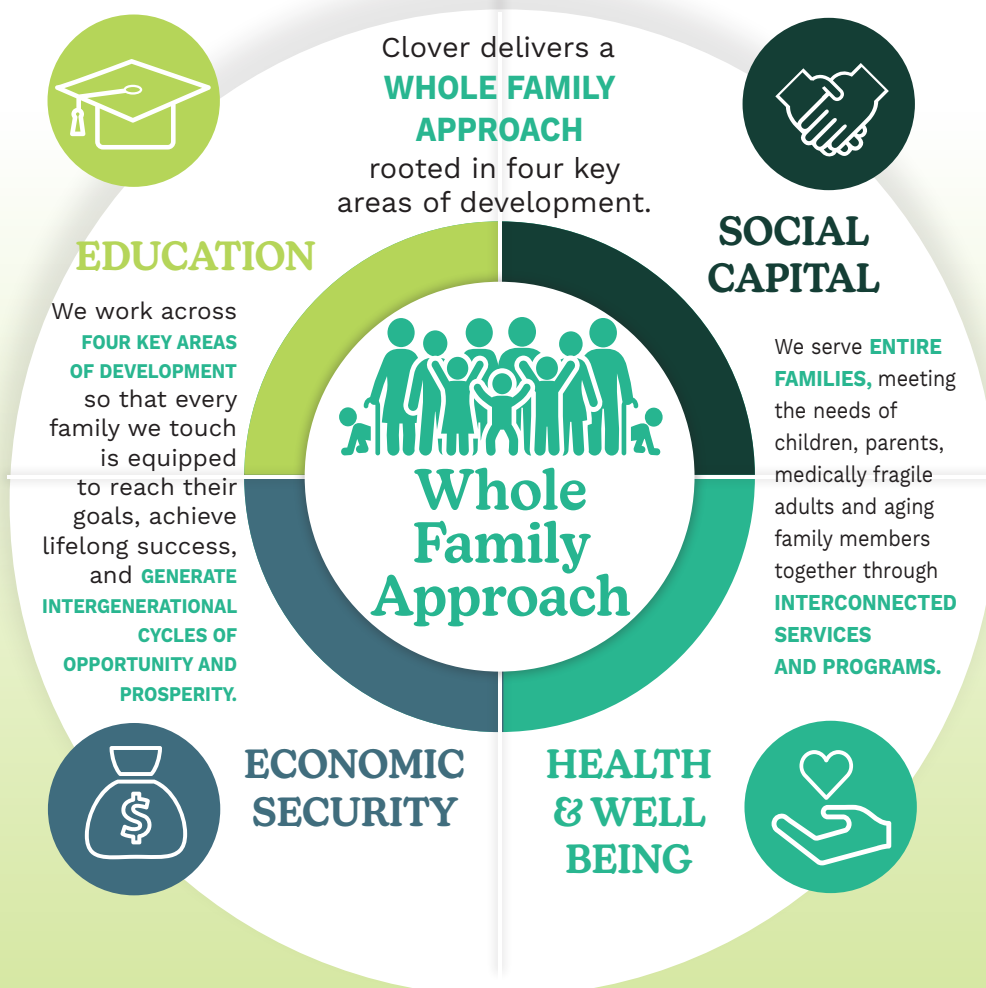
- Career Training and Professional Development Programs
